Accommodation	We guarantee accommodation for exchange students in one of the halls of residence, administered by Studentenwerk Giessen. Application for housing to be done before Jan 15 (spring semester) resp. Jul 15 (autumn semester). The www-link to be used follows with the acceptance letter.
Estimated costs of living	Approximately 860 € per month, for housing (rent approx. 350 €), food, transportation, health insurance etc. Public transportation: Semester ticket (bus, train, etc for all Hesse) included in semester social fee of about 270 € per semester.
Health Insurance	<u>Students from EU-countries</u> must bring along their European Health Insurance Card. <u>Students from non-EU countries</u> must register for statutory health insurance (about 100 € per month).
