

SHORT GUIDE ON HOW TO APPLY FOR IES STUDENT AND YOUNG PROFESSIONALS PAPER ASSISTANCE

1. Upload the final version of the manuscript.
2. Sign off the copyrights to IEEE (it can take up to 24 hours to be registered through all IEEE systems).
3. The paper must be registered (if paid by bank transfer, it is suggested to send us the proof ASAP).
4. Proceed to the “IEEE-IES SYPA” tab.

5. In the line “IEEE-IES Student & Young Professionals Travel Assistance”, press the button in the last column (“Actions”).
6. Fill in the application that includes:
 - Name+Surname (taken from your account information automatically);
 - email (taken from your account information automatically);
 - IEEE Membership Number (make sure no mistakes are made as it can invalidate your application);
 - IES membership info (you must be IEEE IES member);
 - Course of Study;
 - University (taken from your account information automatically);

- Country (taken from your account information automatically);
 - Nationality;
 - City;
 - Past Assistances (this will be verified, penalties will be applied if false information is provided);
 - CV in PDF;
 - Proof of conference registration in PDF;
 - Link to the 3M Video.
7. Submit the application.

Timeline:

1. IES SYPA Application submission deadline – April 30, 2023, 23:59 GMT-7. (Late applications will not be considered)
2. Feedback on the video – May 3, 2023. (You will receive an email with our recommendations/comments from the submission system).
3. Submission of the final 3-minute video – May 7, 2023, 23:59 GMT-7. (The submission system will allow you to modify and resubmit your EXISTING application).
4. Announcement of winners – May 14, 2023.

Important notes:

1. Any IEEE member who graduated from their first university degree (typically Bachelor's) in the past 15 years automatically becomes a Young Professionals member. The organizing committee holds the right to request a proof.
2. A Student/Graduate Student member must carry at least 50% of a normal full-time academic program as a registered undergraduate or graduate student in a regular course of study in IEEE-designated fields. The total cumulative period for a member to hold the Student member grade and/or the Graduate Student member grade is limited to eight years. The organizing committee holds the right to request a proof.
3. The assistantship is limited to 1500 USD per person.
4. BOTH grades for paper and video will influence your final SYPA ranking, i.e., your chances of getting the scholarship.
