


GREN FUTURE ENERGY SCHOLARSHIP

We invite you to apply for the Gren Future Energy Scholarship if you are ready to collaborate with an energy producer and supplier operating in the Baltic States, the Nordic countries, and the United Kingdom, offering green, reliable, and affordable energy. Our locally rooted knowledge and resources enable solutions ranging from sustainable district heating and cooling systems to innovative renewable and industrial energy. In Estonia, we provide district heating in Tartu, Pärnu, Viljandi, as well as Kohtla-Järve and Jõhvi, district cooling in Tartu and Pärnu, and industrial energy solutions across the country.

The Gren Future Energy Scholarship aims to promote and support education in the energy sector, inspire students to engage more deeply in their studies, and ensure long-term development and external talent growth in the field.

- 1. The Gren Future Energy Scholarship** is intended for up to two successful **bachelor's and/or master's students (including integrated learning and applied higher education)** studying at the School of Engineering at Tallinn University of Technology who meet the following criteria:
 - Matriculated at TalTech and not on academic leave as at the moment of submitting the application;
 - Study performance volume at least 30 ECP by the day of submission of the application;
 - Good study performance;
 - Is interested in future-proof energy, thinks big, acts boldly, and is willing to apply their expertise in collaboration with Gren (e.g., internship, employment, research, etc.). The exact form of cooperation will be determined by an agreement between the scholarship recipient and the scholarship provider.
- 2.** The source of the scholarship is the amount transferred to the TalTech Development Fund by the scholarship sponsor.
- 3.** The bachelor's study scholarship amount is **2000 euros** and the master's study scholarship amount **3000 euros**. The scholarship is paid out in a single installment.
- 4.** The scholarship shall be applied for and awarded by way of public competition. The competition shall be announced via various communication channels of TalTech.
- 5.** In order to apply for the scholarship, applicants shall have to submit the following to the Management Board of the Development Fund:
 - a motivation letter in which the student justifies their desire to collaborate with Gren and, if possible, explains how they see this collaboration (internship, work, write a thesis on a topic of interest to them in collaboration with Gren experts, etc.).



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- *Curriculum vitae*;
 - an academic transcript (from the dean's office);
 - a recommendation letter from a lecturer, internship supervisor, former employer, or the leader of a (student) organization where you have been actively involved is beneficial.
6. The Management Board of the Development Fund shall register the applications submitted for the scholarship and organise the forwarding of the documents to the sponsor. Upon its wish, the sponsor may meet with the scholarship applicants before selecting the receiver of the scholarship.
 7. The receiver of the scholarship shall be approved by the Supervisory Board of the Development Fund on the basis of the sponsor's proposal. The scholarship shall be paid to the bank account notified by the receiver of the scholarship to the Management Board of the Development Fund.
 8. Any problems that might arise related to awarding the scholarship shall be settled by the Management Board and the Supervisory Board of the Development Fund.
