

RUUKKI SCHOLARSHIP

- 1. Ruukki Scholarship** is intended for one successful student of the School of Engineering at Tallinn University of Technology, enrolled in Materials Technology, **Integrated Engineering**, Product Development and Robotics, Architecture or Civil Engineering and Construction Management, who meets the following criteria:
 - matriculated at TalTech and not on academic leave as at the moment of submitting the application;
 - average grade at least 3.5;
 - study performance volume at least 60 ECP by the day of submission of the application;
 - an individual with a proactive approach to life and a strong passion for their field, whose goal is to develop into a leading professional within the industry;
 - opportunity to join the innovation team, receive mentorship, complete an internship, participate in a job-shadowing program, and engage in professional collaboration at Ruukki Products AS. The specific form of cooperation shall be determined by agreement between the scholarship recipient and the sponsor.
- 2.** The source of the scholarship is the amount transferred to the TalTech Development Fund by the scholarship sponsor.
- 3.** The scholarship amount is **2000 euros**. The scholarship is paid out in four parts.
- 4.** The scholarship shall be applied for and awarded by way of public competition. The competition shall be announced via various communication channels of TalTech.
- 5.** In order to apply for the scholarship, applicants shall have to submit the following to the Management Board of the Development Fund:
 - a concept proposal (approximately one A4 page), in which the applicant presents an innovative idea related to Ruukki's products and services that could offer entirely new solutions to its customers. Ruukki is seeking boldness, creativity, and forward-thinking approaches — solutions that elevate the industry to the next level and help shape the future by integrating sustainability, technology, and practicality.
 - *Curriculum vitae*;
 - an academic transcript (from the dean's office);
 - A recommendation letter from a lecturer, internship supervisor, former employer, or the leader of a (student) organization where you have been actively involved is beneficial.
- 6.** The Management Board of the Development Fund shall register the applications submitted for the scholarship and organise the forwarding of the documents to the sponsor. Upon its wish, the sponsor may meet with the scholarship applicants before selecting the receiver of the

scholarship.

- 7.** The receiver of the scholarship shall be approved by the Supervisory Board of the Development Fund on the basis of the sponsor's proposal. The scholarship shall be paid to the bank account notified by the receiver of the scholarship to the Management Board of the Development Fund.
- 8.** Any problems that might arise related to awarding the scholarship shall be settled by the Management Board and the Supervisory Board of the Development Fund.
