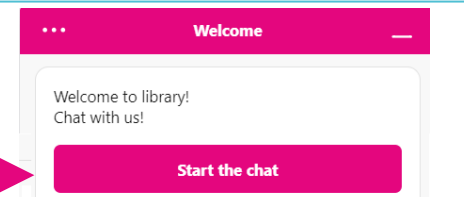

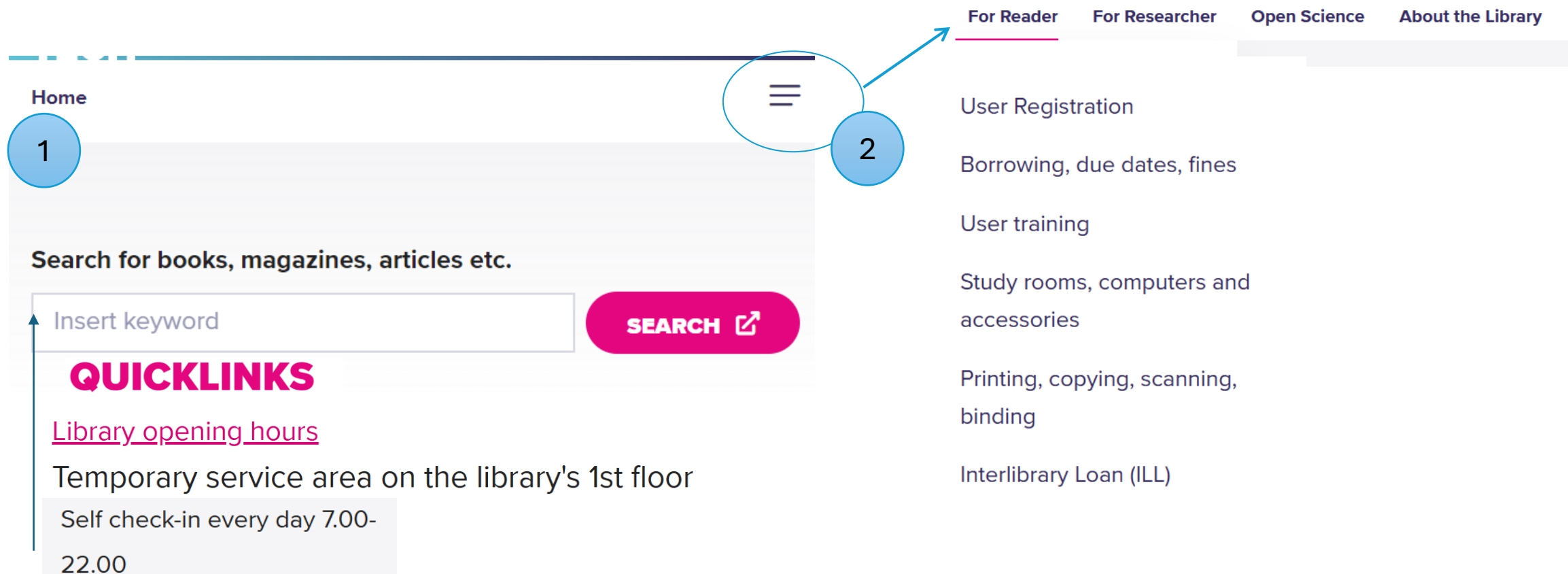

WHERE THE LIBRARY IS RIGHT NOW

- The library is open throughout the year.
- Only II-IVth floor is being renovated. It is due to finish in November 2026.
- Until then there is a temporary service point on the ground floor of the library building (LIB-134). You can borrow and return books, use a computer workstation, browse new arrivals, print, copy, scan and ask for advice.

Everything digital works, majority of these can be used from anywhere. Only the building is limited.



Main study areas for TalTech students:

1. 24/7 open **SOC-219**, former Computer lab for lectures, access is with TalTech ISIC
2. 24/7 **SOC** building I floor (+partly II floor)
3. 1- or 2-person "**silence booths**" are available in the SOC 1st floor lobby and in the 2nd and 3rd floor corridors; NRG in the 2nd floor atrium, U01 in the cafeteria area and lobby, U04 in the 1st floor corridor

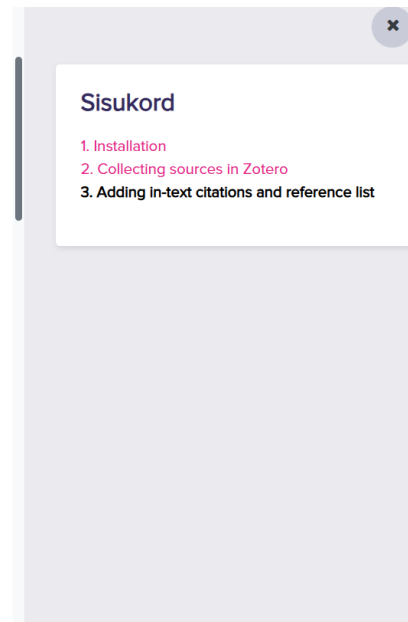
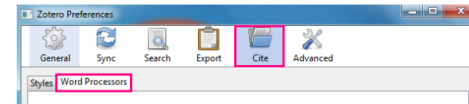
• Zotero tab in Word

Zotero plug-in was installed automatically during downloading Zotero.



If you still don't have it, you can add it manually: open Zotero → Edit → Preferences → Cite → tab Word Processors. Click Install Microsoft Word Add-in or LibreOffice Add-in button, depending on software you use. Please close Word in advance, and then restart Zotero.

If you have a lot of items collected to Zotero, tick "Use classic Add Citation dialog" box.

Percentage of Remote Employees in Education

23.15%

In 2023, 23.15% of employees in the education sector worked remotely. This figure places education in the middle range of industries for remote work adoption, significantly behind technology (67.75%) and finance (48.72%), but ahead of sectors like healthcare (12.24%) and food & accommodation (11.39%).

The overall trend of remote work has been steadily increasing, with 28% of global employees working remotely in 2023, up from 20% in 2021. However, the education sector's remote work percentage is slightly below this global average.

It's worth noting that remote work policies and adoption rates can vary significantly by country and organization size. For instance, in Japan, 23.7% of workers in the education and learning support industry had engaged in telework, closely aligning with the global figure for education.

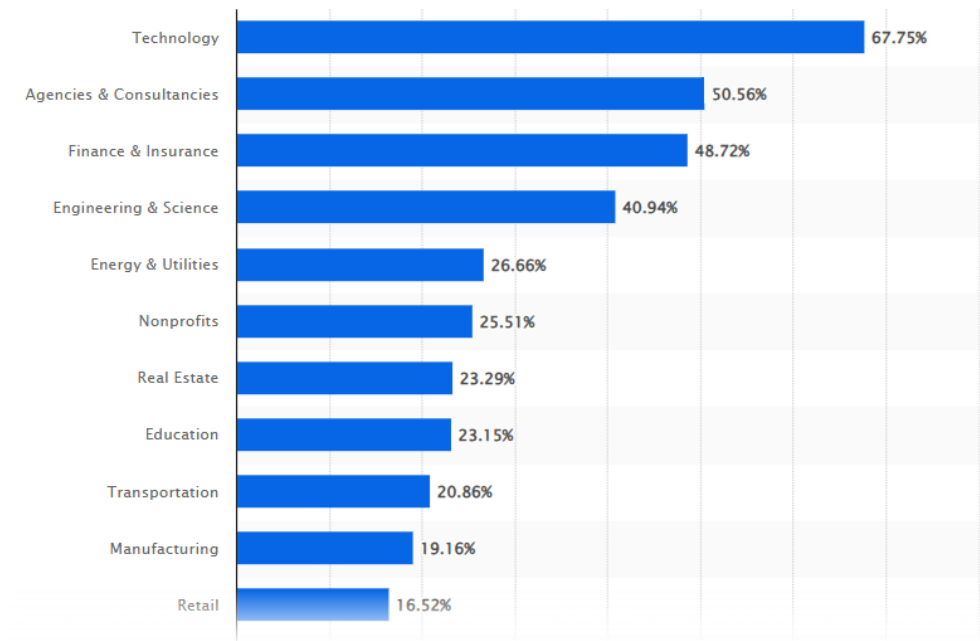

HOW TO APPLY FOR STUDY ACCOMMODATIONS

1

GET VALID DOCUMENTATION

A doctor/specialist certificate, disability decision, or reduced work ability decision that supports the need for accommodations

2

IDENTIFY WHAT YOU NEED

Think through which accommodations would help. The special needs counsellor can help you clarify your needs.

3

SUBMIT THE APPLICATION

Send a digitally signed application and supporting document to the Counselling Office who will issue a document of justification.

4

AGREE WITH EACH LECTURER

Show the Counselling Office confirmation and accommodation list to the lecturer. You do not need to share your medical document with the lecturer.

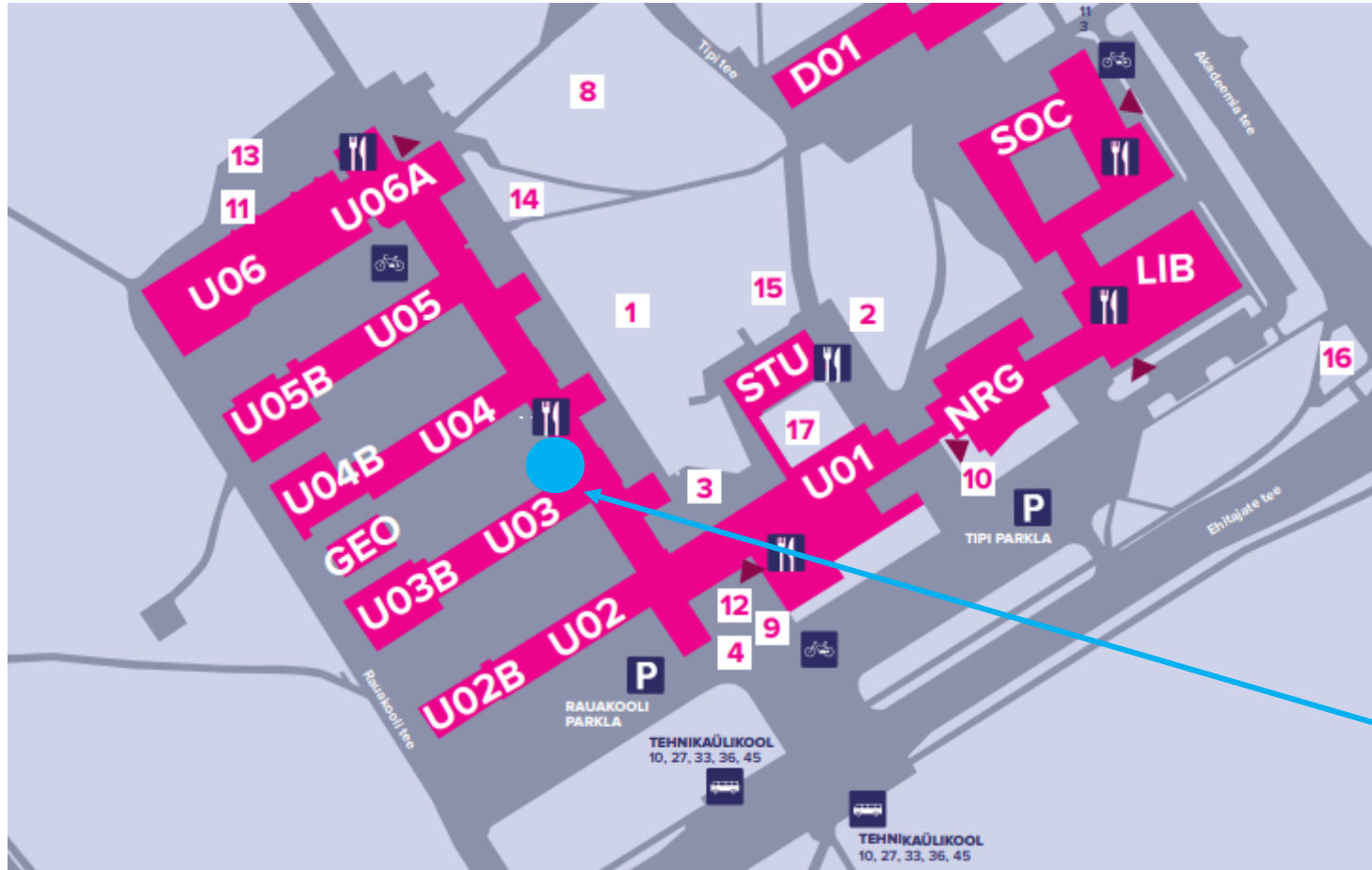
EXAMPLES OF ACCOMMODATIONS

- extra time or rest breaks during exams
- a separate or quieter exam room
- alternative format (e.g. oral vs written)
- accessible learning materials / larger print
- reasonable flexibility with deadlines
- use of a laptop, interpreter or support person
- practical accessibility arrangements

- Start early — accommodations cannot be applied retroactively.
- Agree accommodations separately for each course.
- The confirmation is valid for the semester of issue and the following semester.

ASSESSMENT OF ACADEMIC PERFORMANCE

- The final grade can be calculated as a total of different components (homework, test, exam, assessment) or based only on an examination or assessment at the end of study period.
- If the final grade is partially or entirely based on the results of continuous assessment, the assessment criteria and the weight of the results of continuous assessments in the final grade, incl. possible prerequisites for eligibility for assessment, as well as the deadlines for the performance of the assignments, shall be specified in the extended syllabus of the relevant course.
- If a student does not fulfil the prerequisite for eligibility for assessment indicated in the assessment criteria, the student will not be able to achieve a positive final result in the course.
- For non-graded assessment the final grade shall be determined by a threshold; when learning outcomes of a student comply with or exceed the threshold, the assessment shall be indicated as adequate – A (pass), or, in case the student's learning outcomes fail to comply with the threshold, the assessment shall be indicated as inadequate – M (fail)

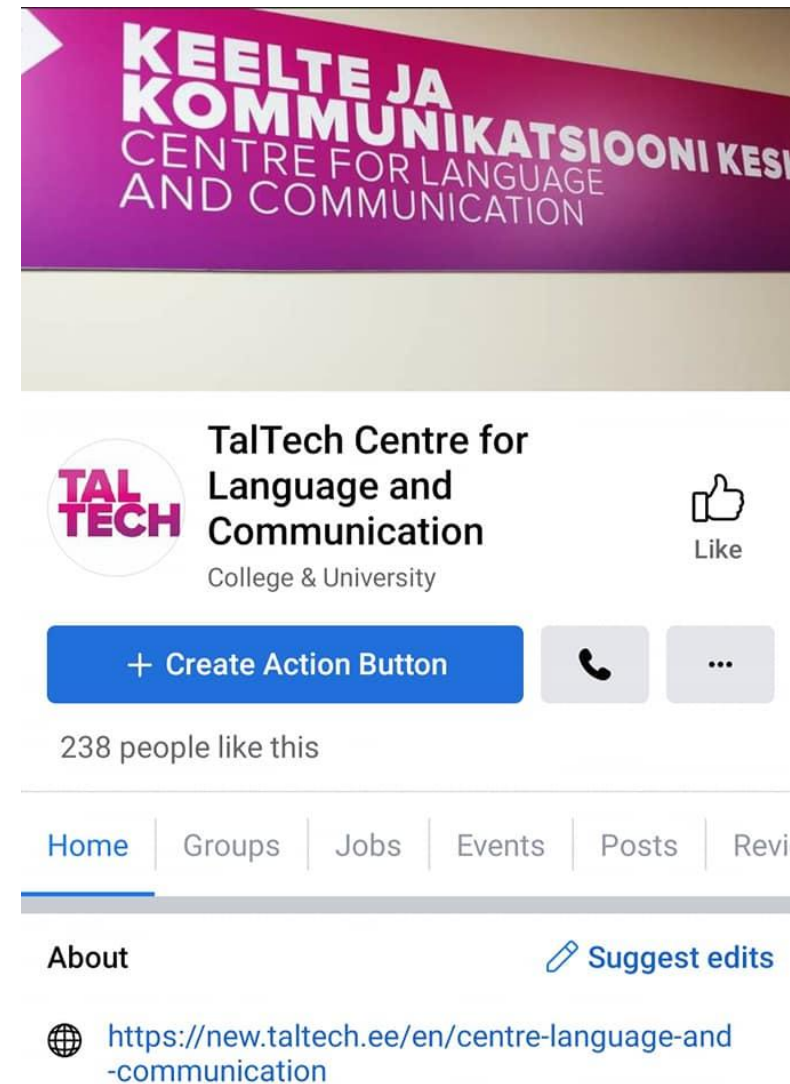
