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PROGRAMMES AND PARTNER UNIVERSITIES

Student Exchange Programs:

- Erasmus+ partner universities by TalTech schools
 - Erasmus Worldwide – project based
- NORDTEK – network of technical universities in the Nordic and Baltic countries

TalTech Bilateral Agreements – partner universities outside of Europe

Free mover – a student who studies abroad independently, instead of going through an official exchange program between universities. Host university might ask tuition fee

ERASMUS PHYSICAL MOBILITY FOR STUDIES

- Coursework
 - Combined studies (courses+internship)
 - Thesis writing
-
- Courses has to be corresponding to TalTech ones - consult with **Programme Director**
 - After exchange, courses will be transferred to TalTech as pass/fail
 - **15 ECTS per semester** is required
 - Minimum period **2 months, max 12** (1-2 semesters)
 - Study fees waived at the host university (except for free-movers)

ERASMUS+ SCHOLARSHIP (1)

EU MEMBER STATES AND THIRD COUNTRIES ASSOCIATED TO THE PROGRAMME

674 EUR per 30 days – Austria, Belgium, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Iceland, Ireland, Italy, Liechtenstein, Luxembourg, Netherlands, Norway, Sweden

606 EUR per 30 days – Cyprus, Czech Republic, Greece, Latvia, Malta, Portugal, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain

550 EUR per 30 days – Bulgaria, Croatia, Hungary, Lithuania, North Macedonia, Poland, Romania, Serbia, Turkey

There is an additional co-financing grant on behalf of the Estonian Government, **72 EUR** (one time payment)

ERASMUS+ SCHOLARSHIP (2)

ADDITIONAL FUNDING AND INCLUSION SUPPORT

Erasmus+ fewer opportunity top-up

Students who are entitled to additional scholarship of **250 euro top-up in a month** are as follows:

- recipient of Estonian [need-based study/special allowance](#)
- parent of minor child/children
- from foster care background
- with diminished work ability
- with health related special needs or chronic illness

Fill in the Declaration of Honor (request from the Mobility Centre) with supporting documents and send it to mobility@taltech.ee for the following dates:

- exchange studies for autumn or full academic year - **15th of July**
- exchange studies for spring semester - **15th of November**

Inclusion support

Additional Erasmus+ funding to help cover extra costs for students with fewer opportunities or specific needs. For example it can help cover extra costs related to your mobility, such as disability or health-related needs, special accommodation or travel arrangements ect. This additional support grant is a contribution based on real costs.

- Standard travel – up to 2 travel days (1+1) of additional individual support
- Green travel – up to 6 travel days
- Green travel options: train, bus, carpool

TALTECH SCHOLARSHIP FOR BILATERAL AGREEMENTS

It is possible for students to apply for a TalTech Scholarship when going to study abroad with our [bilateral agreements](#)

This application round we will be giving out **5x1000 EUR**

- **Motivation Letter** (2500 characters, without spaces)
- 5x1000 EUR per Academic Year, one time payment
- Add the additional Motivation Letter to your SoleMove application

EXCHANGE ON THE LAST SEMESTER: THESIS WRITING OR COURSEWORK

Thesis writing: can be written during your exchange on your **final semester**, when it will be also defended in TalTech. Student must have **two supervisors**: one from TalTech (main) and one from the host University (co-supervisor)

- Student must find a co-supervisor from the host University
 - Co-supervisors confirmation is needed:
 - For Autumn semester, by May 1
 - For Spring semester, by November 1

NB! Before applying, it is crucial to ensure that the chosen host university offers options for thesis writing within their institution. The student is responsible for independently seeking a co-supervisor from the host university.

Coursework: all courses has to be passed and transferred to TalTech before thesis defence.

Funding can be given for Autumn semester until **December 15**, for Spring semester until **May 15**.

WHO CAN APPLY AND WHEN?

An applicant should have:

- TalTech **student status**;
- **GPA at least 3.0**;
- sufficient language level – **minimum B2**;
- paid all necessary tuition fees to TalTech;
- provide approval from your supervisor in TalTech if planning to write your thesis abroad.

Application rounds:

- **February** – main applications round (for Autumn or full Academic year)
- **September** – additional application round (for Spring semester)

LANGUAGE CERTIFICATES

- TalTech Centre for Language and Communication tests
- TOEFL tests in TalTech
- Acceptable for SoleMove applications:
 - Proof from Dean's Office that your study programme is taught in English
 - Estonian State examination result 75 points/% (might not be suitable for the host university)
 - Upon successful completion of TalTech Academic English course, the Centre for Language and Communication can issue a corresponding certificate, which is suitable for the application

WHAT TO KEEP IN MIND

When choosing a host university:

- Start from our website, where [partner universities are listed by Study Programmes](#)
 - A broader view is available on SoleMove – [Destination search](#) (add your Faculty/School + Study level to see a correct overview. Keep an eye on ISCED codes!)
- Choose the country based on your financial means
- Follow the information provided on the host universities website for exchange students (*Incoming Exchange, Incoming Erasmus*)
 - Semester dates/academic calendar
 - Course catalogue + ECTS
 - Accommodation information (whether they have dormitories or other alternatives)

On [SoleMove](#), **submit one application**, listing **up to 3 host university preferences**.

NB!

- **Keep in mind:** during the additional application round, some places may already have been filled during the main application round. If your preferred destination does not appear as an option in SoleMove, all available places have most likely been filled.
- At this stage, TalTech cannot establish new partner agreements for the spring semester.
- If you study abroad during the spring semester, you **cannot extend your mobility to the following autumn semester**. If you wish to continue your studies abroad in the autumn semester, you must submit a new application during the main application round (in February).

FIRST STEPS

1. Gathering information and finding suitable partner universities.

Check the host university's website and the list of courses offered in English.

2. Apply through SoleMove

- Select up to 3 preferred universities, write a **Letter of Motivation**, prepare your **CV** and get your **Language Certificate**. Apply by the deadline.
- Pass the **interviews** in your School – after the application round you will receive the invitation from the Erasmus coordinator

3. Nominations (september-october)

- Official nomination will be made by TalTech to one host university

4. Follow host universities instructions

NON-EU CITIZENS: RESIDENCE PERMIT, VISA REQUIREMENTS

Non-EU students going to EU universities: Visa may be required. Please check with the receiving university or the closest consulate of the chosen country.

NB! The student must have a valid Estonian TRP during their mobility abroad

EU CITIZENS GOING TO EU UNIVERSITIES

If your stay in another EU country is longer than 3 months, you will be required to apply for a residence document confirming your right to live there.

Please note: in some countries you may have to **report your presence upon arrival**

TALLINN UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY



SHORT TERM AND BLENDED MOBILITY ERASMUS+ PROGRAMME

- Short-term **physical presence is 5-30 days**
- **Mandatory virtual part**, no duration requirement (doesn't apply for PhD students)
- Students must receive at least **3 ECTS**
- Blended Intensive Programme (BIP) – same requirements
 - Host university must be TalTech's partner university within the Erasmus+ framework

Scholarship

- Up to the 14th day of activity — 79 EUR per day
- 15th to the 30th day of activity — 56 EUR per day
- 2 travel days (1+1) may be also be covered by individual support

Top-up for students with fewer opportunities:

- 100 EUR for a physical mobility activity period of 5-14 days
- 150 EUR for the one of 15-30 days

ERASMUS+ INTERNSHIP

- Student has to find an internship by themselves
- Length of the internship: **2 to 3 months**
- You **must get ECTS** at TalTech for the internship
- Scholarship: **756-824 EUR** per 30 days

Submit the following documents with your SoleMove applications at least **1 month before the start of the internship:**

- Letter of Acceptance
- Proof of Insurance
- Motivation Letter

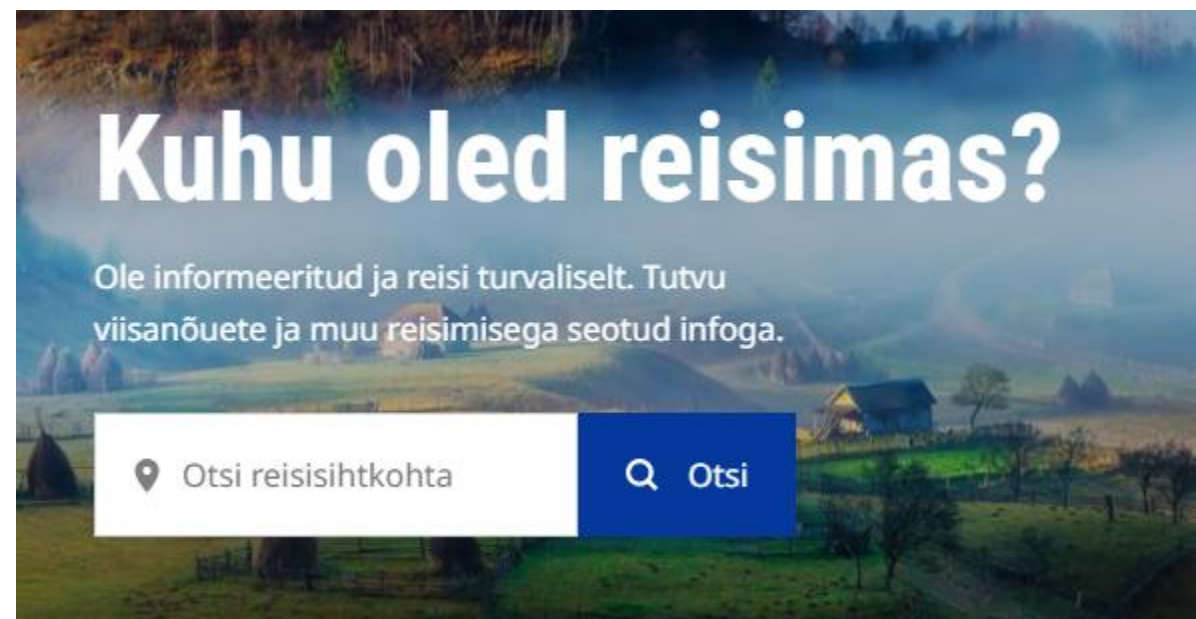
